Course Overview

This course is designed for fire industry practitioners, fire engineers and specifiers to provide them with the knowledge to optimise the use of VESDA in all aspects of fire detection to protect life and property.

- Perform a site assessment, design a pipe network and model this using ASPIRE2
- Install a VESDA system
- Program, commission and maintain a VESDA system

Participants will have access to VESDA detectors and peripheral devices during the practical exercises. They will be provided with VESDA documentation and software, the VESDA System Design Manual and a VESDA Accreditation Course CD.
