## Notifier Power Supply Training

### Course Overview

Notifier Power Supply (NPS) training is for those new to Notifier brand power supplies. Installers, testers and service technicians will find this most useful as the course gives an understanding of power supply functions, fault finding and basic configurations.

### Prerequisites

- Understanding of fire systems
- Basic computer literacy

### Learning Outcomes

On completion of the course, trainees will be able to:

- Define NPS power supply interface (PSI) boards
- Demonstrate termination points for batteries and relays
- Interpret dip switch settings for battery test feature
- Identify various wiring methods on legacy termination boards
- Clarify voltage readings found on NPS PSI boards
- Understand NPS power supply applications and precautions
- Modify voltage settings and adjustments
- Interpret, diagnose and resolve fault messages and indicators
- Perform battery test
- Terminate auxiliary 24 volt terminals.

### Instructional Method

This course is delivered as a group instruction, power point presentation and practical demonstration. Students will have access to an AFP-2800 panel and field devices during the practical exercises. They will be provided with Notifier documentation and a Magni-Fire CD.
