CFP-16 Conventional Fire System Training



Course Overview

CFP-16 Conventional fire panel training is for electricians and fire technicians new to the Notifier conventional fire panel systems. This course gives an introduction to conventional fire systems and will be most useful to beginners to the fire industry.

Training Duration

- ½ day: 8.30am – 1.30pm

Prerequisites

- Understanding of basic fire systems
- Computer literate
- Knowledge of electronics principles

Learning Outcomes

Students at the end of the course will...

- Basic understanding of notifier conventional fire system operation.
- Understand conventional zone circuit principles.
- Terminate conventional zone circuits.
- Diagnose faults on conventional zone circuits.
- Test conventional zones and devices.
- Program conventional zones.
- Program relay outputs.
- Connect, test, fault find sounder and strobe circuits.
- Install and program additional zone and relay cards.

Instructional Method

This course is delivered as a group instruction, power point presentation and practical demonstration. Each student will have a CFP-16 panel in front of them during the practical exercises. They will be provided with Notifier documentation and a magnifier tools CD.
